

Learning Outcomes

Archery



The learning outcomes detailed below can be tailored to suit the needs of an individual group. Objectives and outcomes should focus on a mix of technical skills and soft skills.

Learning Objectives	Learning Outcome
History of Archery	Express an awareness and understanding of the history of archery as an activity.
Coordination	Demonstrate the ability to perform a sequence of locomotor skills with smooth transition.
Correct Draw, Aim and Release	Demonstrate the correct position, posture and technique to draw, aim and release. Student will also demonstrate a basic understanding of aiming techniques.
Correct Hold	Demonstrate confident and correct hold of the bow with little input from the instructor.
Communication	Demonstrate clear briefing and listening skills, learning from the instructor and fellow students without being afraid to ask for help and support when necessary.
Patience	Demonstrate perseverance and patience whilst learning new skills during the activity.
Relationships and Emotional Intelligence	Build positive friendships and bonds with classmates/peers. Able to show understanding and respect for others' opinions, beliefs and boundaries. Learn to handle emotions and behavioural responses.
Teamwork	Able to connect and work with others to achieve a set task.
Environmental Skills	Understand the environment around them and how to act appropriately. Understand basic environmental sustainability and applicable elements of the country code.
